SkillsBoost grants reopening



SkillsBoost Worcestershire helps organisations with the costs of upskilling and training their employees.

Worcestershire organisations can claim 50% of the training costs back, up to £6,000, for their Worcestershire based employees. This means that the new funding can allow organisations to upskill or redeploy their employees to

maximise their effectiveness.

Businesses of any size and sector are eligible for the programme as long as the employees they are looking to upskill or retrain reside in Worcestershire. The SkillsBoost programme is being delivered in collaboration with Worcestershire Local Enterprise Partnership and Worcestershire Growth Hub.

Based on the outskirts of Malvern, Bankside College is a brand-new specialist provision offering high-quality further education for young adults aged 16-25 who are autistic and have multiple complex co-occurring needs. **The College are looking for employers who could support students and potentially offer work experience** so they can gain experience and develop their skills and confidence.

Work experience is typically a half or one full day and would be arranged for a time in the week to suit the employer. The student will initially be

Innovation Worcestershire - No More Solo

A few years ago, while looking for ways to meet new people and share experiences, Ryan Breakwell found a gap in the market.Ryan's vision was clear, to create an app that helps people find genuine companionship for holidays, hobbies, and everyday activities. Worcestershire County Council introduced Ryan to Real World Consultancy (RWC) specialists in business coaching for early-stage entrepreneurs. Through personalised one-on-one coaching, RWC helped Ryan explore critical aspects of business development.

With expert guidance, Ryan successfully applied for an Innovation Grant to use advanced dating app algorithms to power the connection-matching features of No More Solo. The coaching also helped him navigate marketing, PR, branding and design.

Frank P Matthews, a local tree farm and nursery based in Tenbury Wells, is on its way to expanding its customer base after receiving a grant from Enterprising Worcestershire. This



initiative has enabled this 120-year-old business to not only vastly improve their set-up time but also attend more shows, such as the RHS Malvern Spring Festival, BBC Gardeners World Live Show and Shrewsbury Flower Show.

Charles James, Director of Frank P Matthews recognised the need to improve the logistics and labour involved in exhibiting at RHS (Royal Horticultural Society) shows. Seeking to expand their client base across Worcestershire and exhibit at more events, Charles applied to the Enterprising Worcestershire new start-up grant to invest in an exhibition trailer.

Grants Now Available for Worcestershire Businesses to Cut Energy Costs



Businesses in Malvern can now access generous support to improve energy efficiency and reduce costs, thanks to grants from the Business Energy Advice Service (BEAS).

Fully funded by the government, BEAS offers local businesses a free, expert energy assessment and access to grants ranging from £1,000 to £100,000. These grants can be used to invest in equipment and machinery improvements as well

as upgrades such as efficient lighting systems, heating improvements, solar panels and other smart energy-saving technologies.

To be eligible, businesses must consume 25,000 kWh or more of energy annually. An easy-to-use online eligibility calculator is available to guide applicants through the process.

Malvern Hills Upskilling Grant



Malvern Hills Businesses continue to benefit from the Malvern Hills Upskilling Grant.

The grant scheme provides funding of up to **£1,500** to help with the business cost of training new staff (i.e. apprenticeships, trainee or other). In order to qualify businesses must be based in the Malvern Hills district postcode area, employ fewer than 250 people and pay at least the minimum wage to the trainee for a post of at least 30 hrs a week including training leading to a recognised qualification.

Spread the word about Apprenticeship Bursaries



£500 is available to trainees and apprentices to help cover the cost of travel, equipment, tools and clothing necessary to access training.

The support is available to residents of Malvern Hills District who:

- Earn less than £250 per week.
- Attend a qualifying course.
- Are employed for a post of 30 hours a week for a minimum of 12 months.
