**NOTICE OF THE CLOSURE OF C2087 RHYSE LANE, TENBURY WELLS,
WORCESTERSHIRE ("THE HIGHWAY")**

Reason for restriction: Burst water main. There is a likelihood of danger to the public or of serious damage to the road. There is a need to close the highway in the following terms:-

1. The effect of this Notice is that no vehicle shall proceed along that part of the highway from its junction with B4204 Kyrewood for a distance of 530 metres in a north easterly direction.
2. This provision shall continue in force for a maximum of 21 days; however, it is anticipated that it will remain in force for 3 days (24hrs) commencing 10 September 2025.
3. Alternative routes: B4204 Kyrewood, A4112 Teme Street into Shropshire, A456 Worcester Road, A456 Newnham Bridge, A443 Newnham Bridge, C2091 Eastham, C2087 Eastham, C2087 Lower Rochford, C2087 Rhyse Lane (part) and vice versa.

Nothing in this Notice shall prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the highway, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from and only from the highway.
